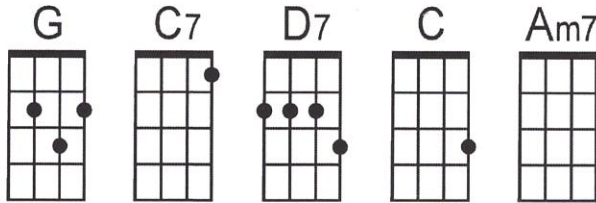


Goin' Up the Country (Key of G)
