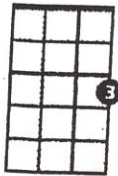


SINGIN' IN THE RAIN

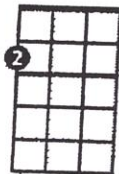

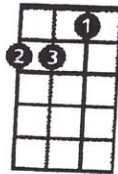
